Project 2:- Capacity Enhancement of Under-utilized CNG Outlets

Project Description: Detailed study on the exceedingly low sales figures of 20 CNG stations (bottom 20 stations) and observed that in few outlets the capacity utilisation (which is calculated as a ratio of sales volume to total capacity) of gas compressors were quite low and therefore a survey was conducted to determine the reasons for low capacity utilization of these bottom 20 CNG stations and suggested possible ways to enhance the capacity utilization in near future.
